What are the system requirements?

CPU: Intel-based Mac computer (2.2 Hz Intel Core2 Duo processor or greater recommended)

Free hard disk space: 7GB

Minimum Operating Systems: Mac OS X Lion (10.7) or OS X Mountain Lion (10.8)

RAM: 4GB recommended

A DVD-ROM drive for installation

A Nuance-approved noise-canceling headset microphone for Mac (included in purchase)

Note: An Internet connection is required for automatic product activation (a quick anonymous process)

Can Dragon Dictate Medical for Mac coexist with previous versions (MacSpeech Dictate Medical)?

Technically, yes both can be installed but we do not recommend both installed at the same time. Please uninstall MacSpeech Dictate Medical before installing Dragon Dictate Medical to eliminate any potential confusion.

How do I upgrade from MacSpeech Dictate Medical to Dragon Dictate Medical for Mac?

There is a detailed process buying the software as well as for exporting your MacSpeech Dictate Medical 1.5 custom vocabularies, uninstalling the old software, installing Dragon Dictate Medical for Mac, and importing the custom vocabularies. For more information, please see Nuance's Knowledgebase.

What do I need to know about vocabularies?

Dragon Dictate Medical contains vocabularies covering more than 90 specialties and subspecialties, so it is likely that your specialty will appear on the list. If your specialty is not covered, you should choose either the general medicine or the specialty vocabulary that is closest to the specialty you perform.

Will Dragon Dictate Medical for Mac be available in other languages?

Not at this time – just US and UK English.

What's the different between Language and Accent and Vocabulary?

A language covers the spelling and formatting of things such as postal codes, addresses, telephone numbers, and units of measure. In the US and UK, there are major differences in those formats and some word spellings, so it makes sense to choose a language based on what geographic area is most appropriate for your dictation despite whatever accent you may have. You can always customize as needed. The English software comes with a choice of US or UK English.

Once you select a language, select an accent. This is specific to you and how you talk. So if you live in the United States but speak with a British accent, choose British. Dragon Dictate Medical for Mac's acoustic models will work best if they know what accent you have before you begin.

Finally, choose a vocabulary. This is your medical specialty and there are more than 90 options available. Pick the one that best suits your needs or practice. It will have the most comprehensive vocabulary list for your medical specialty pre-installed and ready for your dictation.

What if I practice more than one type of medicine and want to use more than one medical vocabulary?

To select a new vocabulary, just create a new profile. When you switch between medical specialties, switch profiles and Dragon Dictate Medical for Mac will capture your vocabulary most accurately.

What about Canadian English?

Since Canadian English is a hybrid of US and UK, users typically chose US English for formatting purposes and customize their vocabulary on the words that they find are not their preferred spelling.

Can more than one doctor use the software? Can I install on more than one computer?

The EULA (end user licensing agreement) of Dragon Dictate Medical for Mac is “speaker-based” meaning that one single user can install on multiple computers but only that one person can use the software.

What’s the difference between Dragon Dictate for Mac 3 and Dragon Dictate Medical for Mac?

Dragon Dictate Medical for Mac is built on the same base platform as Dragon Dictate 3 and has almost all of the same benefits, features and functionality of Dragon Dictate 3 except we have removed social media sharing, smart formatting in order to comply with HIPAA guidelines. Also, we have added in the benefits of Dragon Medical Practice Edition’s medical vocabularies and acoustic models.

Is Dragon Dictate Medical for Mac HIPAA Compliant?

Yes, no data is transmitted outside the program and no audio files are stored.

Is there a general English vocabulary?

No. Only the 90+ medical vocabularies are available in the medical edition.

Does Dragon Dictate Medical for Mac work with the PowerMic 2?

Not at this time.

Is Dragon Dictate Medical for Mac available for Volume Licenses?

Not at this time.
